NUL SENATE STATEMENT ON RESUMPTION OF LECTURES – September 2017

Following the suspension of lectures by the Senate Executive Committee of the University on the 30th August, 2017, Senate held a special meeting today on Monday 4th September, 2017 to review progress made in the processing of students' allowances and consider when lectures may resume.

At this special meeting, Senate made the following key decisions;

1. That resident students should return to the Roma campus from Tuesday 5th September, 2017 in order for lectures to resume on Wednesday 6th September, 2017;
2. That since the grace period for academic registration ends on the 11th September, 2017, all students must complete registration before the end of the grace period;
3. That the University Management will institute investigations on the recent students' riots to ensure that instigators of such acts are dealt with accordingly;
4. That when students return to campus on Wednesday, they will each be required to sign a pledge of commitment to abide by the rules and regulations of the University as provided for in the Students' Handbook and other regulatory frameworks; and
5. That the University will hold a meeting of parents and guardians of NUL students on Saturday 9th September, 2017 at 10.00am to discuss ways in which they may assist the University in its attempts to curb the seemingly deteriorating students' behavior.
