POST NO. 2305 – LECTURER/SENIOR LECTURER: HYDROLOGY AND WATER RESOURCES STUDIES

The Department of Geography and Environmental Science seeks a Lecturer/Senior Lecturer with broad expertise and experience encompassing surfaces and subsurface hydrology applied to water resource assessment and development at catchment and regional scale.

PROFILE OF THE SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATE

Research: The successful candidate may have a core research expertise in any aspect of applied surface and/or subsurface hydrology, but should also show evidence of broader spanning water quality and quantity, as well as experimental and modeling approaches. The candidate should demonstrate profound understanding of catchment hydrological processes and the link with the catchment characteristics and geomorphology. Specific areas of knowledge include but are restricted to river basin dynamics, catchment response to land use changes, river flow and flood modeling, flood risk assessment, surface water management planning, wetland hydrology and wetland potential assessment. Good command of Geographic Information Systems (GIS) is an added advantage.

Requirements:

The applicant should have the following credentials:

- Minimum MSc. degree in hydrology, hydrogeology, water science or a related field of earth sciences; a PhD will be an added advantage;
- Relevant professional experience in developing countries;
- Excellent command of the English Languages;
- Willingness to supervise undergraduate student projects;
- Experience lecturing beginners in water science.

Contract Duration:

The appointment for position shall be on contract for a period of **two years**.
