The National University of Lesotho invites applications from suitably qualified candidates for the following post:

POST No. 2790 - LECTURER/SENIOR LECTURER (Chemical Technology)

DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY AND CHEMICAL TECHNOLOGY

Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for one position of Lecturer/Senior Lecturer in the Department of Chemistry and Chemical Technology. This position will be permanent and pensionable for Lesotho nationals, but full time on contract for an initial period of two years with a possibility of subsequent renewal(s) for non-locals upon satisfactory performance.

REQUIREMENTS:

The minimum qualification for this post is MSc in Chemical Engineering or any related field with a strong background in Chemistry, but preferably a PhD in Chemical Engineering or any related field and a minimum of two years teaching experience at a university will be considered. Appropriate research experience and substantial experience of teaching Chemical Engineering, Applied Chemistry and Chemistry Courses at the university will be an advantage.

Applicants who wish to spend at least one (1) year on sabbatical leave may be considered.

DUTIES:

Duties will include courses

- Teaching of Chemical Technology, Applied Chemistry and Chemistry courses to both undergraduate and postgraduate students.
- Supervision of laboratory sessions for the practical components of courses assigned to teach
- Supervision undergraduate and postgraduate students' projects
- Participate in the research activities of the department
- Writing research proposals that can attract research funds, designing new courses and/or programmes for undergraduate and postgraduate training in Chemical Technology.
- Any other duties as may be assigned by the department from time to time.

The successful candidate will be expected to resume duty on **01 August 2019**.
