ON BEHALF OF MYSELF AND THE ENTIRE UNIVERSITY COMMUNITY I WISH TO SINGLE THEM OUT FOR SPECIAL TRIBUTE AND CONGRADULATIONS. THEIR ACHIEVEMENT OF HAVING CLAMBERED TO THE VERY SUMMIT OF EDUCATION'S THABANA-NTLENYANA IS EVERY REASON FOR THEM TO BE VERY VERY PROUD.

HONOURABLE GUESTS

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN

THE NATIONAL UNIVERISTY OF LESOTHO IS A NATIONAL INSTITUTION, A PROPERTY OF THE NATION. AND AS SUCH WE ARE ALWAYS ACUTELY AWARE OF ITS OBLIGATION TO KEEP THE NATION ABREAST WITH DEVELOPMENTS IN THIS, THEIR INSTITUTION. THERE CAN NEVER BE A BETTER OPPORTUNITY THAN THAT PROVIDED BY GRADUATION CONVOCATIONS TO GIVE A BIRD'S EYE VIEW REPORT OF PROGRESS IN KEY PERFORMANCE AREAS OF THE UNIVERSITY'S STRATEGIC DIRECTION. AS IT IS A TRADITION, ALLOW ME TO BRIEFLY DO SO.

THIS YEAR, A TOTAL OF 2412 SAT FINAL YEAR EXAMINATIONS ACROSS ALL FACULTIES AND THE INSTITUTE OF EXTRA MURAL STUDIES. 2,239 OF THEM WILL BE GRADUATING WITH CERTIFICATES, DIPLOMAS, BACHELORS DEGREES, POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMAS, MASTERS AND DOCTORAL DEGREES IN THE TWO CONVOCATIONS OF THE 22ND AND 29TH SEPTEMBER 2018 REPRESENTING A 93% SUCCESS RATE. PERHAPS A MORE RELEVANT MEASURE OF PERFORMANCE IS: WHAT PERCENTAGE OF OUR STUDENTS COMPELETE THEIR STUDIES ON THE PERIOD PRESCRIBED FOR A PARTICULAR QUALIFICATION? STATISTICS SHOW THAT OF THOSE WHO ENTERED THE UNIVERSITY IN 2014 TO PURSUE A FOUR YEAR DEGREE AND SHOULD BE COMPLETING THIS YEAR, 67% OF THEM WILL BE RECEIVING THEIR DEGREES THIS MORNING AND NEXT WEEK. BENCH-MARKING WITH OTHER UNIVERSITIES I AM AWARE OF, THIS IS NOT BAD AT ALL. BUT I BELIEVE THAT GOING FORWARD, WE MUST COMMIT TO LIFT IT TO ABOVE THE 70% WATERMARK.

SINCE THE UNIVERSITY RESUSCITED POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES AND INTRODUCED NEW ONES A PATTERN IS BEGINNING TO SHOW IN GROWING SUCCESS RATES. THIS YEAR ALMOST THREE TIMES MORE POSTGRADUATE CANDIDATES WILL BE GRADUATING THAN IN 2017. IT IS IMPERATIVE TO SUSTAIN THIS MOMENTUM IN VIEW OF THE UNIVERSITY'S COMMITMENT TO GROW ITS POSTGRADUATE FOOTPRINT TO ABOUT 5% OF THE TOTAL ENROLMENT BY 2020. INDEED THAT TARGET IS ATTAINABLE CONSIDERATION BEING HAD TO THE FACT THAT ALL FACULTIES INCLUDING IEMS HAVE ROLLED OUT POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES IN 2018/19. WE CAN NOW WITH FULL CONFIDENCE DECLARE THAT GONE ARE THE DAYS WHEN FOR ALL INTENTS AND PURPOSES NUL WAS A LITTLE MORE THAN A COMMUNITY COLLEGE. I AM CONFIDENT THAT OUR POSTGRADUATE FOOTPRINT WILL ALSO POSITIVELY IMPACT OUR REGIONAL AND

GLOBAL RATING. TO THIS END, I CONGRADUATE THE FACULTY OF HUMANITIES FOR THEIR TWO DOCTORAL GRADUANDS. THE FACULTY IS CLEARLY ESTABLISHING ITS PRE-EMINANCE AS THE LEADER IN DRIVING DOCTORAL OUTPUTS. THAT IS A CHALLENGE FOR OTHER FACULTIES TO UP THE ANTE!

YOUR MAJESTY AND CHANCELLOR,

HONOURABLE GUESTS

IN NUL STRATEGIC PLAN 2015-2020, AND MORE SPECIFICALLY IN RESEARCH AGENDA 2016-2020, WE COMMITTED TO TARGETS IN THE GROWING OF NUMBERS OF PhD HOLDERS AND THE PROFESSORiate AS RATIOS OF OVERALL ACADEMIC STAFF. THE COOPERATION OF COLLEAGUES STRIVING TO EARN DOCTORAL DEGREES IS TRULY INSPIRATIONAL. OF THE FACULTIES INVOLVED IN TODAY'S CEREMONY PATTERNS REFLECT A COMMENDABLE PROGRESS. 35% OF ACADEMICS PRESENTLY HOLD DOCTORAL QUALIFICATIONS IN THE FACULTY OF LAW, AND THE DEAN INSISTS THAT I SHOULD INDICATE THAT THIS IS FROM A VERY LOW BASE OF 5% IN 2015. IN THE FACULTIES OF EDUCATION AND HUMANITIES 63 AND 65% RESPECTIVELY HOLD PhDs. THESE ARE NO DOUBT COMMENDABLE FIGURES AND WE WISH TO APPLUAD THE STAFF FOR THEIR EFFORTS AND THE DEANS OF THESE FACULTIES FOR THEIR STERLING STWEARDSHIP. LOOKING AT THE DATA ACROSS ALL FACULTIES THESE TWO FACULTIES HUMANITIES AND EDUCATION ARE CLEARLY THE UNIVERSITY'S TORCH BEARERS IN THIS SPACE.

IN THE DEVELOPMENT, ATTRACTION AND RETENTION OF THE PROFESSORiate, WE COULD DO BETTER AS ONLY 8% OF THE ENTIRE ACADEMIC CADER ARE IN THE RANKS OF ASSOCIATE AND FULL PROFESSOR. THIS IS AN AREA WHERE THE UNIVERSITY SUFFERS A VERY HIGH ATTRITION RATE AS A RESULT OF RESIGNATIONS

BECAUSE OF NUL'S DEPLORABLY LOW SALARIES AND POOR WORKING CONDITIONS IN GENERAL, WHICH RENDER THE INSTITUTION ABYSMALLY UNCOMPETATIVE. WE HAVE SEEN A REGRETABLE SPIKE IN THE GRAPH OF THOSE LEAVING THE UNIVERSITY IN THE PAST ONE YEAR.

YOUR MAJESTY AND CHANCELLOR,

IN RESEARCH AGENDA 2016-2020 WE ISOLATED EIGHT RESEARCH FLAGSHIPS ALIGNED TO OUR DISCERNMENT OF THE CRITICAL DEVELOPMENTAL CHALLENGES FACING THE COUNTRY. THE AREAS IDENTIFIED INCLUDED:

- POVERTY STUDIES
- INDIGENOUS KNOWLEDGE
- LEADERSHIP STUDIES
- HIV AND AIDS
- RENEWABLE AND SUSTAINABLE ENERGY AND CLIMATE CHANGE
- WATER STUDIES
- MIGRATION STUDIES AND
- INNOVATION

SIGNIFICANT PROGRESS HAS BEEN REGISTERED IN THE FOLLOWING DOMAINS:

COUNCIL ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE UNIVERSITY SENATE HAS APPROVED THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE NUL WATER INSTITUTE (NULWI), A DEVELOPMENT THAT HAS GENERATED HUGE INTEREST FROM STAKEHOLDERS IN GOVERNMENT, PARASTATALS AND THE PRIVATE SECTOR. THE APPOINTMENT OF ACADEMICS WHO WILL TAKE STEWARDSHIP OF THE INSTITUTE IN TEACHING AND RESEARCH IS ALREADY UNDERWAY AND IT IS EXPECTED THAT

TEACHING PROGRAMMES WILL BE SUBMITTED FOR COUNCIL ON HIGHER EDUCATION'S ACCREDITATION VERY SOON.

IN THE FACULTY OF HUMANITIES AT LEAST THREE INDIGENOUS KNOWLEDGE COURSES HAVE ALREADY BEEN INTRODUCED AND CURRENTLY A FULLY-FLEDGED MASTERS PROGRAMME IS BEING DESIGNED. COLLEAGUES IN THE HARD SCIENCE FACULTIES HAVE DEVELOPED MEDICINES AND DRUGS, FOODSTUFFS AND OTHER USABLE PRODUCTS WITH INDIGENOUS PLANTS, SOILS AND OTHER RAW RESOURCES FOUND IN LESOTHO.

IN THE AREA OF RENEWABLE AND SUSTAINABLE ENERGY SHORT COURSES ALREADY STARTED IN 2017 TRAINING WELL OVER 100 COMPATRIOTS. MORE EXCITING, AN MSC IN RENEWABLE SUSTAINABLE ENERGY COMMENCED A FEW WEEKS AGO WITH AN INITIAL COHORT OF 23 ENTHUSIASTIC CANDIDATES ENROLLED.

A FORMAL SUBMISSION FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE MOSHOESHOE PEACE AND LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE (MPLI) IS ON THE WAY TO SENATE AND COUNCIL IN THE WEEKS AHEAD. MEANWHILE UNDER THE STEWARDSHIP OF COLLEAGUES ASSIGNED TO INCUBATE THE INSTITUTE, SHORT COURSES AS WELL AS POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES ARE DUE TO BEGIN IN 2019.

A MULTIDISCIPLINARY TEAM OF COLLEAGUES ARE WORKING ON AN HIV AND AIDS RESEARCH PROJECT SUPPORTED BY BRISTOL MEYERS SQUIBB FOUNDATION.

IN THE SPACE OF INNOVATION WE HAVE REGISTERED TREMENDOUS STRIDES THAT HAVE CAUGHT THE ATTENTION OF ALL AND SUNDRY. THE UNIVERSITY WILL DEDICATE A WEEK DURING THE MONTH OF OCTOBER TO PROVIDE OPPORTUNITY FOR THE UNIVERSITY STAFF AND STUDENTS, GOVERNMENT, MEMEBERS OF PARLIAMENTS AND

OTHER STAKEHOLDERS TO GET TO KNOW NUL BETTER. THIS EVENT, DABBED NUL WEEK WILL SHOWCASE AN ARRAY OF SCIENTIFIC INNOVATIONS HAPPENING AT THE UNIVERSITY. IT IS ALSO OUR HOPE THAT HIS MAJESTY WILL FIND TIME IN HIS BUSY SCHEDULE DURING THAT WEEK TO COME TO CAMPUS TO INAUGURATE FOUR IMPORTANT INNOVATION PROJECTS, NAMELY:

- THE INNOVATION HUB BUILDING,
- THE BOHLALE BAKERY,
- THE SEBABATSO YOGURT FACTORY AND
- THE POULTRY PROCESSING INITIATIVE WHICH WILL SOON GRADUATE INTO A CHICKEN ABATTOIR.

THE LAUNCH OF THESE PROJECTS - AND MORE ARE IN THE PIPELINE - IS A FORCEFUL EXPRESSION OF OUR INTENT TO BECOME AN ENTREPRENEURIAL UNIVERSITY. THE PROJECTS LAY A SPRINGBOARD FROM WHICH THE UNIVERSITY'S VISION, COMMITMENT, STRATEGY AND ABILITY TO CONTRIBUTE MEANINGFULLY AND TANGIBLY TO THE NATIONAL EFFORT OF TURNING LESOTHO'S ECONOMY TO A PRODUCTIVE ECONOMY, SHALL BE TRIAL-TESTED.

A HIGHLIGHT OF THE ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE ACADEMIC MUST WITHOUT A DOUBT BE THE SUCCESSFUL NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF LESOTHO INTERNATIONAL SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY CONFERENCE (NULISTICE) AND RENEWAL ENERGY SYMPOSIUM (RERIS) HELD PARALLEL TO EACH OTHER IN MASERU IN FEBRUARY. SCORES OF SCIENTISTS AND PRACTITIONERS FROM ALL OVER THE GLOBE DESCENDED ON LESOTHO TO SHARE AND LEARN FROM OUR PRACTITIONERS THOUGHTS AND EXPERIENCES ABOUT TECHNOLOGY AND ENTERPRENURSHIP AS CRITICAL STIMULANTS OF CONTEMPORARY DEVELOPMENT. NOT ONLY WAS THE CONFERENCE AND SYMPOSIUM HIGHLY SUCCESSFUL, THEY PROVIDED AN

INVALUABLE PLATFORM FOR NUL ACADEMICS TO BENCHMARK WITH THE BEST IN THE WORLD. I SEIZE THIS OPPORTUNITY TO APPLAUD THE ORGANISERS AND PARTICIPANTS OF THAT EVENT THAT HAS WITHOUT A DOUBT PUT NUL AND LESOTHO FIRMLY ON THE MAP.

ALLOW ME THEREFORE, TO THANK FROM THE BOTTOM OF MY HEART THOSE IN THE LOCAL CORPORATE WORLD WHO HAVE SUPPORTED THE UNIVERSITY BY CONTRIBUTING IN MODEST, ALBEIT SINCERELY APPRECIATED WAYS, TO ENABLE IT TO REACH MANY OF THE MILESTONES WE HAVE AND CONTINUE TO ACHIEVE. METROPOLITAN LESOTHO HAS BECOME A PURVAYER AND CONSISTENT FORCE OF GOOD IN THIS REGARD. THE LESOTHO POST BANK AND THE LESOTHO NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, UNDP, LESOTHO FUNERAL SERVICES ARE SOME OF THE PARTNERS WITH WHOM WE ARE DESTINY FOR A LONG HAUL RELATIONSHIP. WE HAVE ALSO SINCERELY APPRECIATED THE EFFORTS OF *THEPOST* NEWSPAPER WHICH VIRTUALLY EVERY WEEK PUBLISHES CREATIVE WORKS CARRIED OUT BY OUR STAFF AND STUDENTS THEREBY ENSURING THAT THE REMARKABLE MASTERY OF TECHNOLOGY BY OUR SCIENTISTS GET TO BE KNOWN AND APPRECIATED BY THE LARGER PUBLIC HERE AT HOME AND ELSEWHERE. AN INNOVATION WEBSITE HAS ALSO BEEN LAUNCHED TO ASSIST IN THE EFFORT TO INFORM THE PUBLIC ABOUT THE INNOVATIONS.

WHILE ON THE IMPORTANT MATTER OF INNOVATIONS, I CAN HARDLY RESIST THE TEMPTATION TO MENTION AN IMPORTANT JOINT NUL-LNDC PLAN PRESENTLY IN THE WORKS. THE PLAN ENTAILS THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN INDUSTRIAL PARK IN THE ROMA VALLEY TO BED DOWN FOR A START, 10 FACTORIES THAT WILL PRODUCE ON A SUSTAINABLE AND INDUSTRIAL SCALE SOME OF THE PRODUCTS COMING OUT OF THE UNIVERSITY'S

LABORATORIES WHOSE PROTOTYPES ALREADY QUALIFIED FOR THE MARKET. IT IS OUR FIRM CONVICTION THAT THE FACTORIES WILL BE LODESTARS TOWARDS INDUSTRIALISATION AND JOB CREATION OUR COUNTRY SO SORELY NEEDS, ESPECIALLY DURING THESE TRYING ECONOMIC TIMES. FEASIBILITY STUDIES ARE ALREADY UNDERWAY.

FROM THIS PUBLIC ROSTUM I WOULD LIKE TO THANK THE PRINCIPAL CHIEF OF HA MAAMA, MOFUMAHALI MABELA MAAMA AND THE CHIEFTAINNESS OF THE VALLEY, MOFUMAHALI MAMOHLE MAAMA, AND THEIR COMMUNITIES FOR ALLOWING THE UNIVERSITY A FREE HAND TO PICK ANY SUITABLE LAND OF ITS CHOICE AS THE SITE FOR THE PROJECT.

THIS REPORT WOULD NOT BE COMPLETE WITHOUT MENTIONING THE FACT THAT NUL IS INCHING CLOSER TO ACHIEVING ONE OF ITS KEY STRATEGIC GOALS. I WISH TO THANK THE MINISTRY OF DEVELOPMENT PLANNING WHO HAVE COMMITTED TO PROVIDE THE UNIVERSITY WITH FUNDS NECESSARY FOR ENVIRONMENTAL AND SOCIAL IMPACT, SURVEY AS WELL AS FOR ARCHITECTURAL DESIGNS FOR THE SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING BUILDING. THE UNIVERSITY SINCERELY APPRECIATES THE COMMITMENT OF THE GOVERNMENT TO SOURCE FUNDING FOR THE SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING BUILDING. THE NEED FOR SUCH

A SCHOOL BECAUSE OF ITS IMPORTANCE TO HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT, ESPECIALLY AS THE COUNTRY EMBARKS ON BIG PROJECTS SUCH AS PHASE 2 OF THE LESOTHO HIGHLANDS WATER PROJECT AND FOR THE GROWING MINING SECTOR, CAN HARDLY BE OVER-EMPHASISED.

GRADUATION CEREMONIES ARE ALSO AN OPPORTUNITY TO RECOGNISE AND CONVEY OUR GRATITUDE THOSE WHO HAVE CONTRIBUTED TO THE SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THE GRADUANDS' STUDIES, NAMELY PARENTS, GUARDIANS, THE GOVERNMENT OF LESOTHO THROUGH THE NATIONAL MANPOWER DEVELOPMENT SECRETARIAT LOAN SCHOLARSHIP FUND AND OTHER SPONSORS. RECENTLY SEKHAMETSI DEVELOPMENT TRUST SIGNED A MEMORUNDAM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE UNIVERSITY TO SUPPORT IT TO THE TUNE OF OVER M900,000 OVER A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS STUDY; AND TEACHING AIDS FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES. SOME OF THESE HIGH-TECH AMENITIES ARE ALREADY IN USE AND THEY HAVE TRAMENDOUSLY EMPOWERED STUDENTS LIVING WITH DISABILITY TO STUDY ON A EQUAL FOOTING WITH THEIR PEERS. THIS GENEROUS INTERVENTION TRULY TRANSFORMS AND LEVELS THE PLAYING FIELD FOR OUR DISABLED STUDENTS. TO SHOW ITS APPRECIATION, THE UNIVERSITY HAS DESIGNATED A BUILDING WHERE STUDENTS LIVING WITH DISABILITIES, WILL BE SUPPORTED, AND THE BUILDING IS CALLED SEKHAMETSI CENTER.

AS WE CONGRADUATE YOU FOR THE ACHIEVEMENTS WE ALL ARE CELBRATING TODAY, IT IS MY FERVENT HOPE THAT YOUR TIME AS

STUDENTS AT THE UNIVERSITY HAS PREPARED YOU WELL. SOCIETY EXPECTS THAT YOUR YEARS OF STUDY AT THIS, YOUR ALMA MATER, WERE BOTH INTELLECTUALLY AND SPIRITUALLY FULFILLING. IT EXPECTS THAT YOU LEAVE TECHNICALLY WELL-EQUIPED FOR THE COMPLEX WORLD OF CHALLENGES, AND HARDSHIPS OUT THERE.
