LAUNCHING E-LEARNING SOLUTION WITH ECONET TELECOM LESOTHO

Following an earlier notice to the NUL community that the Senate Executive had decided that teaching and learning activities would continue to take place remotely during the COVID-19 lockdown, the University has finally brokered a deal with Econet Telecom Lesotho and should be able to launch the zero-rated e-learning programme from Thursday 30th April, 2020.

The National University of Lesotho has contracted Econet Telecom Lesotho to offer a service solution that will allow all **registered NUL students** and **servicing staff members** to access teaching and learning materials from the University's learning management system, THUTO, the Library Information System and other selected educational portals free of charge from their devices.

Circular # 8 of the 9th April 2020 provides detailed information on how staff and students may access and benefit from this e-learning opportunity.

It is important for staff and students to note that this negotiated arrangement has so far been agreed with Econet Telecom Lesotho and will therefore be accessible via an ETL sim card.
